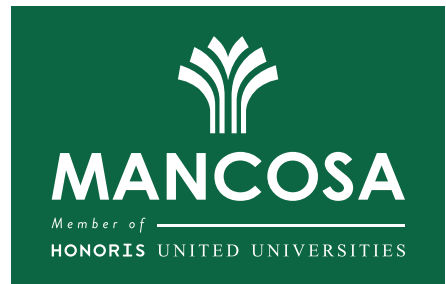

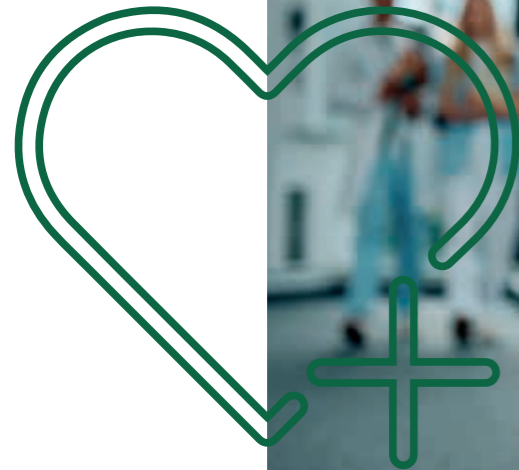

Higher Certificate in Healthcare Management

FORMAL LEARNING PROGRAMME



Programme

The purpose of the Higher Certificate in Healthcare Management qualification is to help aspirant healthcare workers and current healthcare personnel to develop an awareness of healthcare management theories, practices and operations. Furthermore, the student will have an understanding of contemporary managerial practices and the styles of current practice given the nature of dynamic change within healthcare. Equipping employees with a basic understanding of management skills and knowledge will be an advantage to organisations who need competent and knowledgeable employees to assist in the management, operational and administrative tasks.

Admission Requirements

- The minimum entry requirement is the National Senior Certificate or National Certificate Vocational with appropriate subject combinations and levels of achievement; or
- An equivalent NQF level 4 qualification with proven proficiency in English.
- To be considered via RPL, applicants should be above the age of 23 years.

For further information on this alternative route, please contact a student advisor. All applicants with an international qualification will be considered in accordance with MANCOSA's institutional rules.

Articulation

Completion of the Higher Certificate meets the minimum entry requirement for admission to an appropriate Advanced Certificate. A Higher Certificate may also allow access to an appropriate Bachelor's degree.

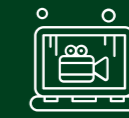

Effective infection prevention and control programmes have been proven to be one of the cornerstones for combating HAIs and antimicrobial resistance” -Dr. T Pillay (acting Director-General: Health, March 2022). 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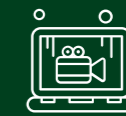

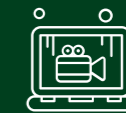
